Just released at Snellville AMC theater is the inspirational true story premier movie of <u>Brian Banks</u>, as an all-American high school football star. His story began June 10, 2013 when he is shown during NFL football rookie minicamp, Saturday, May 4, 2013, in Flowery Branch, GA. He placed himself in the wrong place and position.



Because of this, the woman whose false claim of rape sent former prep football star to prison and ordered to pay a \$2.6 million judgment in connection with the case.

A year into his legal fight, he was in adult court facing 41 years to life in prison. He was 17 at the time. Despite the lack of evidence, **Banks** gets railroaded through a **broken justice system** and sentenced to a decade of prison and probation.

REMEMBER HOWEVER through the persevering prayers of his Mom and divinely chosen "innocence advocates", God exposed a criminal system needing repairs.

"Some plant, some water, but God brings the increase." When visions are seen that are beyond your scope, God has the power to accomplish them through anyone He chooses. JUST GOT TO WAIT. In 2006 our prayer team spent months praying over these 3 vacant buildings at 3005 Lenora Springs Dr. Snellville for recovery centers previously occupied by Gwinnett CO. The stake was spiritually placed there, but no ministries to occupy it. But within the past 4 years, 2 of the buildings are now established churches! There now remains one last building, the largest one, still empty!

Yet in God's divine providence through our Greater Gwinnett Reentry Alliance, I met Pamela Hillman who is a testimony of the power of God to radically change a woman from sexual assaults and drugs. She discovered that only through memorizing the Word of God, and being led by the Holy Spirit, could the healing process begin.

Pamela has even forgiven those who have tied her up, choked her, raped her, beat her, and even shot at her through experiencing the lasting change of true deliverance that comes through the same program that she has developed.

This radical transformation lead her into founding LifeChangers Legacy. The mission of LifeChangers

Legacy is to empower, train and equip those in prison and 'Returning Citizens;" to restore them to their families; live a new Christ-centered lifestyle in spiritual, physical, and financial wellness, giving back to society.

<u>LifeChangers Legacy's</u>, Daughters of Zion Transitional Living Program (<u>DOZ</u>) is a comprehensive wraparound program to provide our mentees/clients personalized care, skills and a Christ-centered lifestyle necessary to successfully transition back into their communities from prison. <u>But there is a serious shortage of transition housing, particularly for women. PRAY that God will open the doors to this vacant building.</u>

DOZ interfaces with our "I See ME Free", a 4 Phase workbook, mentor and incentive program for those incarcerated. Both LifeChangers Legacy programs are ones of personal responsibility and meaning which break the bonds of addiction by fostering Christ-centered transformational beliefs, thinking and behaviors. Their mentees will receive from the DOZ program what they put into it with the help of our staff of Case Managers, Clinical Coordinators, House Directors and Mentors. Their rules, policies, and procedures are Biblically-based, meet state guidelines and are in place to ensure the safety, health and overall well-being for the ladies returning from prison, their staff and the communities to which our ladies return.

The setting – DUI COURT – a wonderful place to hang out. A 100 % audience of folks who have not learned to put down alcohol especially while driving. My brief time I spent with Morris was priceless.
