The very first posted sign in the lobby of the Gwinnett Co. Detention Center is the **SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY OFFICE**. That is a huge red flag bigger than our nation is willing to admit. In Georgia, there are 20,000 sex offenders (with 244 violent sexual predators required to wear a monitor for life,) GBI statistics show.

The rest of the offenders are considered a low or moderate risk or have never been assessed and assigned a risk level, officials say.

But after counseling thousands of inmates and families in the court halls, it can be traced back to the **real undertaker** that started with that **“FIRST LOOK”**. The 20,000 sex offender list has failed to trace what Jesus radically declared in His Sermon on the Mount. That **first look**, when not brought under arrest, has brought more men to a fatal destruction than we could humanly record.

The Old and New Testament specifically list sexual sins that are called despicable acts of impurity, orgies, adultery, and homosexuality as being sexually immoral. **Then the church at large succumbs to a silent role, failing to rebuke such sins.**

Then someone goes to jail! My diagnostic assumption next is, “You weren’t living together, right?”

For which their response is **“YES”**. The police charges don’t usually record fornication, but my response then is, “God had to separate them for sexually illegal relationships”. At that very moment, I get a 100% agreement! When I ask them to read out loud the flyer **Covenant Love VS Convenient Love** the point is well taken. **Then I lead them in prayer asking for God’s forgiveness of their iniquity of lust that led to commit adultery.**

God said it is time as your last opportunity to make your choice. Instead of thinking the negative outcome of my situation, maybe to think about how I can apply and make some positive changes.

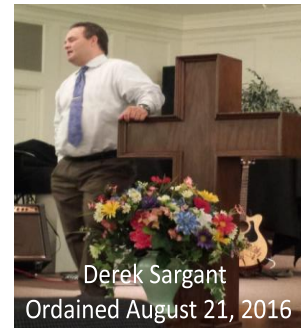
I find myself resisting lustful thoughts and I have been removing myself from lustful conversations. I also have made a decision to abstain from sex before marriage.

MENTORING MEN IN THE FAITH

Being involved in a mentor program isn't just a good idea, it is a biblical idea. Throughout the scriptures we can see mentor programs taking place. In Exodus 18:13 we see Moses going about his duties as a judge. Moses makes the comment to his father-in-law that they are coming to him for nearly every reason. If Moses had continued in this way he soon would have gotten burned out and not been the effective leader that God called him to be. In Exodus 18:17 Moses father-in-law steps in and gives him very needed mentoring. He gives Moses the very sound advice that doing this alone will quickly wear him out and make him ineffective. Another good example of biblical mentoring can be found in 2 Timothy 1:2, in the father/son relationship of Paul and Timothy. You can see the love and devotion that Paul has for Timothy when he says, "To Timothy, My beloved child." So from this we can ascertain that in a mentor relationship there needs to be a great and Godly love between the mentor and mentored. I believe this love can best be defined

as the love that Paul describes in 1 Corinthians 13:1-13. There is one other aspect of the mentor program that can be seen in first and second Timothy. The mentor, in this case Paul, was instructing his young son in the ministry in the ways to be effective for carrying out the gospel of Jesus Christ. One last thought on mentoring from first and second Timothy is the responsibility of the person being mentored. In 2 Timothy 2 Paul says these words, "***My child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Jesus Christ, and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses in trust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.***" This has been done for me. David Burgher, president of Bridge the Gap Ministries, has known me nearly all of my life. He has been a father figure to me as much as Paul was to Timothy. At the time ten years ago when I received my calling into the ministry from our Lord, David was the first one to approach me and ask me to pray very diligently, to seek God in the matter about entering into a mentor relationship with him.



Throughout time and distance David has never abandoned post as the mentor that God has called him to be. It is important to understand what this dedication and devotion means for the life and the ministry of the mentored. I have stayed with my calling. I have graduated from Seminary, have recently been ordained and now am fulfilling my calling of reaching the lost through Jesus Christ. I am being used by Him in the roll of interim Pastor at a local Baptist Church.
